We are asking that you be aware of where your children are:

If they continue to congregate and refuse to leave the area, the likelihood is that parents will be contacted and asked to collect their children either from that location or the police station itself.

This may result in further action being taken.

These are unprecedented times and we as the Middleton Neighbourhood Policing Team are asking for you as parents to support not only us but the Community and business community at large by knowing where your children are and being in contact with them on a regular basis.
