Educational Provision for “most vulnerable” students from Tuesday 24th March 2020

As you will be aware the Academy is offering emergency provision for the children of key workers and those who are deemed “**most vulnerable**”, including those with social workers and education, health and care plans (EHCP) only.

From tomorrow, Tuesday 24th March the Academy will be open to students at **8.30am** (not 7.30am) and will close at **2.40pm** as normal. We are now operating with a skeleton staff.


Please note the following points:

- students can now wear their own clothes to school; school uniform is not required
- we will plan some exercise into the daily routine, such as a walk around the school grounds, so students can bring their PE kit to change into if they choose to do so. However this is not compulsory
- students can bring their own food such as a drink bottle or snacks to eat throughout the day. The Academy will provide lunch
- students may also want to bring a book to read or a game (cards, board game etc) to play during lunch time
- students will complete a variety of work and different activities with a range of staff throughout the week. There will also be an opportunity for students to work independently and they will be supervised and supported to do so

We have reminded students about current Government guidance on personal hand hygiene and social distancing. Please discuss this at home and ensure they understand the importance of these.
