Dear Parent/Carer

As your children come to the end of their time at St Anne's Academy, may I take the opportunity to thank you and to thank them for all their hard work over the past five years. Over this time I have been impressed with their character, sense of community and how they have worked so positively throughout this most important year of their secondary education.

Firstly, school for Year 11 will finish today, Tuesday 11th June. We will hold a celebratory final assembly at 2:30pm for students who would like to stay for this, finishing at approximately 3:15pm. There is no requirement for students to attend timetabled lessons after this time. However, from tomorrow, Wednesday 12th June, we are holding revision sessions for students which they are encouraged to attend. If your child attends, then they are required to wear full school uniform and come in for those sessions only. It is important that we support the success of Year 11 without disrupting the learning of others.

Secondly, I still expect all students to sit their exams in their full school uniform. I have key reasons for this, in that it ensures students focus on their work and not on what they are wearing; it maintains a calm, purposeful and orderly environment around the school and ensures that students remain part of the St Anne's community.

Finally, your child should have a copy of this letter plus the revision session timetable shown overleaf. This will also be available on EduLink.

Sitting GCSEs can be an intense experience for all the family. I advise students to revise regularly for short amounts of time, to take breaks and to make sure they are fully hydrated. They do have to work hard but, as always, if you are worried about your child, please don't hesitate to contact any one of us at school.
